

Mayberry Comes to Westminster

Mayberry Festival welcomes arts & crafts exhibitors and food vendors. Thank you in advance for helping to insure the high quality of our event. We ask you to please follow these rules:

1. The hours for the festival are Friday April 20, from 12 noon until 8:00 p.m. and Saturday April 21 from 9 a.m. until 6 p.m. You are expected to stay set up for the duration of the show. It will NOT be canceled for bad weather. We will be at the corner of Lucky Street & Main Street at 8:30 am Friday morning to assign your space. You will not be allowed to set up before this time. All traffic must enter Main Street (at Rite Aid) in one direction during the festival. You will be given a space number upon arrival. Do not call ahead asking for your space number. Those of you, who have canopies, bring blocks to anchor your corners because you will be on the street.
2. Vendor spaces are non-transferable.
3. Priority is given to crafters who make their own wares. Items sold strictly by retail are discouraged and are given lowest priority.
4. We expect all vendors to present a clean and orderly appearance.
5. Each rented space is ten feet by ten feet (10X10). You may rent more than one space. All of your wares, booth equipment and tie-downs must be within the space(s) you rented. No wares may be placed outside of your rented space. The festival reserves the right to site and assign spaces to all vendors. We cannot accommodate special requests.
6. All vehicles must be moved out of the Festival area by 11:00 a.m. Friday morning. No vehicles will be allowed back into the festival area before 6:30 p.m. on Saturday and until you are completely dismantled and ready to load.
7. Each vendor is responsible for the security of their concession booth, wares and vehicles. On Friday night a special security guard will patrol the entire grounds. Officers from the Westminster Police Department patrol the area occasionally; however security is your responsibility.
8. The following items are strictly prohibited from sale or as awards or prizes: Any type of aerosols, poppers, silly string, stink bombs, alcohol, fireworks of any type, weapons, knives (except those that are hand made by the exhibitor and approved in advance of set up by the event chairman), toy cap pistols, caps for cap pistols, bows and/or arrows of any type or any item deemed controversial, tasteless or offensive by the festival staff. You may be asked to leave the festival if you are in violation of these rules.
9. You are responsible for collecting and reporting South Carolina sales tax.
10. Returned checks will incur a \$35.00 processing fee in addition to the amount of the check. All concession fees remitted after the deadline must be in the form of a money order. The deadline for submitting Arts, Crafts and Food Applications is April 1.
11. Violation of these rules may result in removal from the Arts, Crafts, and Food Show and denial of future participation in this event.
12. These rules will be strictly enforced in the interest of safety and to promote this event as a family type of festival. If you have a problem with any of these rules, consider another event in place of this one. No warnings will be issued for infractions. You will be asked to leave without a refund.

We welcome you as a visitor and concessionaire to the Mayberry Comes to Westminster Festival and trust we both will enjoy a profitable relationship for years to come.
